Fátima » Coimbra » Aveiro

ITINERARY

- 1 → 09:00AM → We start our adventure, departing from the comfort of your hotel.
- 2 → Our tour starts with a visit to the houses of the Three Little Shepherds in Aljustrel.
- 3 → We continue to the Hungarian Calvary, a place of meditation and peace, which symbolizes the spiritual connection between Fátima and Hungary.
- 4 → Close by, we visit the Chapel of the Apparitions, the exact place where Our Lady made her first apparition to the little shepherds in 1917.
- 5 → We end the morning at the Basilica of Our Lady of the Rosary, which houses the tombs of the Three Little Shepherds and stands out for its imposing and symbolic architecture.
- 6 → Lunch, with your guide offering recommendations for a memorable meal of your choice (not included).
- 7 → Visit to the New Cathedral of Coimbra, an important religious and architectural landmark.
- 8 → We explore the University of Coimbra, one of the greatest national symbols, recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- 9 → We then continue to Largo da Portagem, a charming space that connects the historic center with modernity.
- 10 → We set off on a relaxing cruise along the Aveiro lagoon aboard a traditional moliceiro boat.
- 11 → We visit the charming Chapel of São Gonçálio, one of the city's cultural and religious symbols.
- 12 → Following this, we explore Aveiro's traditional salt pans and learn about the historical importance of salt extraction.
- 13 → We then travel to Costa Nova and admire its famous colorful striped houses.
- 14 → The tour concludes at the iconic Barra Lighthouse, the tallest in Portugal.
